



ANA MEMBERSHIP ASSEMBLY REPRESENTATIVE

ANA Representatives shall be elected from among the individual full members of PSNA for a two (2) year term or until a successor is elected in the following manner:

- a. To serve as a Representative, a member shall be required to hold full membership in PSNA and meet eligibility requirements as established by the ANA.
- b. The President and one additional Representative shall be elected to serve as a Representative to the ANA Membership Assembly (held in June) and special meetings held during their term of office. These two (2) Representative positions shall be counted among the total number of Representatives as determined by the ANA.
- c. Representatives and alternate Representatives shall be elected by plurality vote, the candidates receiving the highest number of votes being declared elected. In case of a tie, the Representative shall be determined by lot. The person receiving the highest number of votes shall be the Representative-at-large.
- d. The remainder of nominees, in order of the number of votes received, shall be elected as alternate Representatives.
- e. Should a board member be appointed Vice President to fill a vacancy, that person may not serve as a Representative unless duly elected as an Alternate Representative.
