



## **PSNA Bylaws Committee**

### **Summary:**

The Bylaws Committee consists of at least three (3) members of which two (2) are full members of PSNA appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Directors. This committee meets once per year (typically face-to-face, although this may change) and only when: (1) there is an anticipated change as requested by the PSNA Board of Directors; (2) there is an anticipated change as requested by the PSNA voting body; or (3) in compliance with changes that may be made at the ANA level that would affect C/SNAs.

### **Roles and Responsibilities:**

1. Receive or initiate proposed amendments to the bylaws of PSNA
2. Present proposed bylaws amendments or revisions to the ANA for approval of harmony
3. Revise and promulgate bylaws as needed
4. The In-State Only Member of the Bylaws Committee does not participate in any bylaws discussions or recommendations pertaining to matters that directly relate to ANA bylaws, e.g., election of ANA Membership Assembly Representatives or ANA bylaws recommendations.

### **Term:**

The term of each member of the PSNA Bylaws Committee shall be one year with reappointment (to a maximum of four years).
